## Attention Installing Personnel

As a professional installer you have an obligation to know the product better than the customer. This includes all safety precautions and related items.

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## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



#### To remove drain pan from coil pan assembly:

- 1. Remove 4 screws holding coil assembly to drain pan.
- 2. Discard the 4 screws.
- 3. Remove the drain pan.

#### To install the high temperature drain pan:

4. Place the coil assembly on to the new high temperature drain pan.

**NOTE:** When installing a high temperature drain pan kit for oil-fired furnace applications be sure to fabricate a 6 inch spacer as indicated below.

5. Install the 4 screws supplied with the kit (#8 X 3/8).
